What is Programming?

Programming involves purposeful planning of activities and meaningful experiences for the children who come to our service. It includes designing a framework which aligns with the My Time Our Place and EYLF Frameworks.

How do we Program?

Through our Program we aim to create engaging learning experiences which are tailored to each child. We collect information for our program through a range of different ways including:

- Reading the information you provide to us about your child on their enrollment form.
- Through conversations with the children and their families.
- Through observations of the children while they are at the service.
- By collecting ideas and suggestions from the children which they write down in our suggestion book.



How can you get involved?

- Speak with our educators or send an email to the service with suggestions.
- Respond or provide suggestions in our Parent suggestion book which is at the sign in/out area.
- Complete the section on the enrollment form which provides us with information about your child.

Where can you find out what is on our Program?

Our Program is displayed on our Parent noticeboards for you and your children to see.

Each day we have a variety of arts and crafts and physical activities for the children to participate in.

Our program shows where the idea has come from (Children's suggestion, follow up activity, parent suggestion etc) and also shows links to our Learning Frameworks.

Each afternoon we reflect upon our daily program as part of our cycle of planning. By reflecting it allows us to ensure that each individual child's interests, well being and development is at the core of our program and so that we are able to extend on the children's interests and learning.
