What's in our Playground?

We have all been excited that the Rainbow Lorikeets have been gathering around our trees and the bird feeder. We encourage them by putting our leftover apple and pear cores (their favourites!) in the bird feeder as well as sunflower seeds. This week we provided the binoculars and the lanyards to identify the types of birds we have in the trees in our playground. Conversations flowed as children matched the birds with those on the lanyards and observed and compared the different types. We supplied reference books and children were encouraged to draw the birds that they saw.

SUSTAINABILITY

Following on with our work on Sustainability this week, we read the book 'In the Bin' and started our own 'landfill' to see what happens to rubbish when it goes to the dump. We plan to dig it up each week to observe the changes that occur over this time - especially the differences between the plastics and the paper products.



We also looked at some videos about where rubbish goes when we put it in the bin - in which coloured bin? The rubbish is then sorted and goes to recycling or landfill.
